CONCRETE TRAILER SAFETY

- 1. Maximum distance from this location is 50 miles
- 2. Towing equipment may cause damage to customer vehicle. Rental Center not held responsible for any damage cause thereby.
- 3. You may be charged for the MT Drum Cover if not returned.
- 4. Under Vehicle Code 29004: you May Not Exceed the mfgs. rated capacity of your hitch, ball, vehicle or trailer.
- 5. The maximum speed while towing a trailer is 45 MPH.
- **6.** Check the hitch installation after loading and unloading the trailer.
- **7.** Never tighten the coupler with a wrench.
- 8. Trailers are not to be disconnected from the towing vehicle. Improper reconnection may result in loss or damage to the trailer or its contents.
- **9.** Trailers are allowed in the right two lanes only.
- 10. Load must be covered if there is a possibility of any debris blowing out of trailer.
- 11. Trailer brake, tail lights, and turn signals are required to be hooked up to the towing vehicle.
- **12.** Mirrors are also required if your vision is obstructed by the trailer or the load.
- 13. All damage to the tires and tubes caused by blowout bruises, cuts, punctures, road hazards or other causes is the responsibility of the customer.

LIABILITY INSURANCE: Customer shall maintain liability insurance covering the operation and use of the vehicle by customer, with limits for bodily injury and property damage at least as high as those required by the Financial Responsibility Laws of the state in which the vehicle is operated and used by Customer. Upon request of Rental Center, Customer shall furnish the name of his insurance agent, insurance company and complete information concerning the liability insurance coverage carried. In the event of Customer's breach of this Rental Agreement by failure to have or obtain such liability insurance, any insurance coverage which may apply to Customer under Rental Center's insurance coverage (which shall be secondary to Customer's insurance coverage) while Customer is operating and using the vehicle is limited to the amounts set forth in the financial responsibility laws contained in California Vehicle Code Section 16056, with a maximum limit of fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000.00) for bodily injury to or death of one person in any one accident and subject to such limit for one person, the amount of thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000.00) because of bodily injury to or death of two or more persons in any one accident, and the amount of five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) for damage to property of others as a result of any one accident, or the amounts specified in any amendment to said law.

NOTE: The driver must have a valid driver's license, meet Rental Center's minimum age requirement, and accept the conditions herein and on the stated Rental Agreement.

CONCRETE SAFETY WARNINGS

Read These Additional Warnings Before Using:

- 1. Concrete and Creeks Don't Mix Please Don't Wash Down The Storm Drain!
- 2. Contains Portland Cement
- 3. Always wear eye protection while working with concrete.
- 4. Never refuel while unit is running and/or hot.
- 5. This item contains one or more chemicals known to the State of California to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm.
- 6. Contact with wet (unhardened concrete, mortar, cement or cement mixtures) can cause skin irritation, severe chemical burns or serious eye damage. Avoid contact with eyes and skin.
- 7. Wear waterproof gloves, a fully buttoned long-sleeved shirt, full-length trousers, and tight-fitting eye protection when working with these materials. If you have to stand in wet concrete, use waterproof boots that are tight at the top and high enough to keep concrete from flowing into them. If you are finishing concrete, wear knee pads to protect knees.
- 8. Wash wet concrete, mortar, cement mixtures from your skin with fresh, clean water immediately after contact, indirect contact through clothing can be as serious as direct contact, so promptly rinse wet concrete, mortar, cement or cement mixtures from clothing. Seek medical attention if you have persistent or severe discomfort. In case of eye contact, flush with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Consult a physician immediately.
- 9. Keep out of reach of children
- 10. User agrees to convey this warning to all persons who may use or come into contact with wet (unhardened) concrete, mortar, cement or cement mixtures.
